

Promoting a Sustainable Market for Solar PV Systems in the ECOWAS Region (West Africa)

Strengthening and developing local capacities of policymakers, regulators, utilities, financial institutions and RE entrepreneurs

Promotion of RE Policies and Incentive Schemes in ECOWAS Countries

Regional Certification Scheme for PV Installers in West Africa



Objective

Support the development of RE market in the ECOWAS region by improving the skills of RE professionals through a regionally harmonized certification system

IRENA's Support for the Initiative

- Development of the institutional structure, rules and procedures of the scheme
- Review of curricula of partnering institutions for compliance with the agreed Job Task Analysis (also supported by IRENA) for off-grid PV technician trainings
- Development of examinations contents for written and practical exams and procedures based on the ISO 17024 standard
- Development of a regional implementation strategy for successful roll-out of the scheme in the member countries
- Supervision of first 2 examinations in end-2018 early-2019, Ghana & Senegal

ECREEE will serve as the governing body of the scheme.
